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In this seminar the reasons why schools and universities might want to work together in the educational context will be explored. Different types and models of partnerships will be considered. Ros McLellan will particularly draw on her experience of coordinating the Schools-University Partnership for Educational Research (SUPER) at the Faculty of Education, University of Cambridge as well as on work she has been done in Kazakhstan. In the seminar not only theoretical arguments and academic research literature will be discussed but also the practical issues that school and university colleagues working together need to consider.

The seminar will appeal to colleagues in both school and higher education settings who are interested in harnessing the power of school-university partnerships. Participants will be encouraged to bring their own experiences to the table, share these within the group and make plans for their own work. A range of activities will support these goals.

Ros McLellan is a Lecturer in Teacher Education & Development / Pedagogical Innovation at the Faculty of Education, University of Cambridge. She has a background in teaching in the secondary school sector in the UK and is a psychologist who is particularly committed to working collaboratively with schools to develop and refine strategies that make a real difference to teaching and learning in the classroom. She is coordinator of the School-University Partnership for Educational Research (SUPER), a long-standing research collaboration between schools and the Faculty of Education, University of Cambridge. Her research interests include teacher learning and development, wellbeing, achievement motivation, self-efficacy, anxiety and creativity.
